
Diary of a Patriot 2020 Mystery Quilt




You will need:


- Twenty-four (24) Clue E blocks
- Sixteen (25) Clue F blocks
- -Four (4) 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ " White Squares

Assembly Tips:

- -Starch and press blocks and strips.
- -All blocks measure 12 1/2" square.
- -Look over diagrams carefully before beginning to assemble.
- -Use an abundance of stick pins when sewing the rows together.
- 1. Cut the 18 ½" white squares as shown. Yielding a total of sixteen (16) setting triangles.




2. Sew two triangles together as pictured to make the corner unit. Press either direction. Make two.



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
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ROW ASSEMBLY



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


QUILT ASSEMBLY


Sew a corner unit to the top of Row 1.




Sew rows 1 & 2 together, making section one.




Sew Rows 3 & 4 together, making section two.




Add Row 5 to the bottom of section two.



Join Section 1 and Section 2 together, forming the top half.




Sew Row 6 & 7 together, making Section 3.




Add a corner unit to the bottom of Row 9.




Sew Row 8 & 9 together, making Section 4. Add row 9 to the bottom of the section.



Join together Section 3 & 4, making the second half of the quilt.



Sew the top half and bottom half of the quilt together.



BORDERS

You will need:

-Ten (10) 3 1/2" x WOF white strips.

PREPRATION:

- 1. Stay stitch around the perimeter of the quilt.
- 2. Cut two of the 3 ½" strip x WOF in half, resulting in four (4) 3 ½" x 22" strips.
- 3. Sew two WOF strips and a 22" strip together. Mitering the joint is optional. It will measure approximately 3 ½ X 110". Make four.

CONSTRUCTION:


Smoothly lay the quilt on a flat surface.
Take three measurements, and average them.
Cut two of the 3 ½" x 110 strips cut the strip to the exact measurement.



Pin the strip to each corner. Find the approximate center and pin. Continue to pin the center of each new division, approximately three inches apart.

Sew the right side from the top to the bottom. Sew the left side bottom to top. Press.

Smoothly lay the quilt on a flat surface.
Take three measurements and average them.
Cut the two 3 ½" x 110 strips to the exact measurement.



Pin the strip to each corner. Find the approximate center and pin. Continue to pin the center of each new division, approximately three inches apart.

Sew the top from left to right. Sew the bottom from right to left. Press.
